- A **“Solemn Resolution”** containing all the decisions and conclusions reached through the website and the “Youth parliament on democracy event” which will be widely circulated to decision makers, youth organizations and media representatives throughout Europe.
- A **video-documentary** will be produced to illustrate the Youth Parliament and present the “Resolution” to a wide public.
